RARC Vision for 2017

- Supports the awareness and growth of Amateur Radio worldwide;
- Strives for every member to get involved, get active, and get on the air;
- Encourages radio experimentation and, through its members, advances radio technology and education;
- And Organizes and trains volunteers to serve their communities by providing public service and emergency communications

 - Need volunteers to represent RARC and staff the table
- Tom Flippin (KD4CMK) has been appointed as the "President's Director"
- The Tech Committee has been formed
 - Tom Flippin has been named Chairman of the Tech Committee
 - Win Grant will represent D-Star interests
 - A team has been formed to establish the goals and objectives of running a Remote Station for RARC members

- The Tech Committee needs volunteers
 - Inventory Manager Allows members to check in/out equipment
 - Remote Administrator Manage the Remote Station and assist members with use
 - D-Star Administrator Manage the gateway, passwords, and assist members with use

- Established a Public Information Officer (PIO) position
 - Dan Bryant (N4DOB) has agreed to be the PIO for 2017
 - Obtain facts and distribute them to the media
 - PIO's produce printed and video material about their organization for dissemination to the public
 - A PIO may be responsible for organizing special events such as news conferences and awards ceremonies
 - Maintaining a social media presence may be part of a public information officer's duties.

- Sponsor the VA QSO Party for 2017
- Tech Testing HT Program
 - Each person who passes their Tech exam AND signs up to be an RARC member will receive a 2m/70cm HT for "free"
 - The RARC Testing Team will deliver the HT to the new member
 - Allan Johnson (WA3J) has agreed to oversee the initial programming and distribution of the HT
 - The HT will not exceed \$30
 - The program will be funded for the 2017 calendar year

- 80% Participation Rate for Members
 - Each member should engage in at least 1 (one) activity during the
 2017 calendar year
 - What counts as an "activity?" Teaching a class; bringing cookies;
 being an officer; presenting; checking into a club net; participating in an RARC sponsored event (Radio Run/Field Day/etc.)
 - The Membership roster "owner" will be responsible for tracking the completion of AT LEAST 1 (one) activity during the calendar year and providing a monthly % update
 - Each member is expected to inform the Membership roster "owner" of completing at least 1 (one) activity/event during 2017
